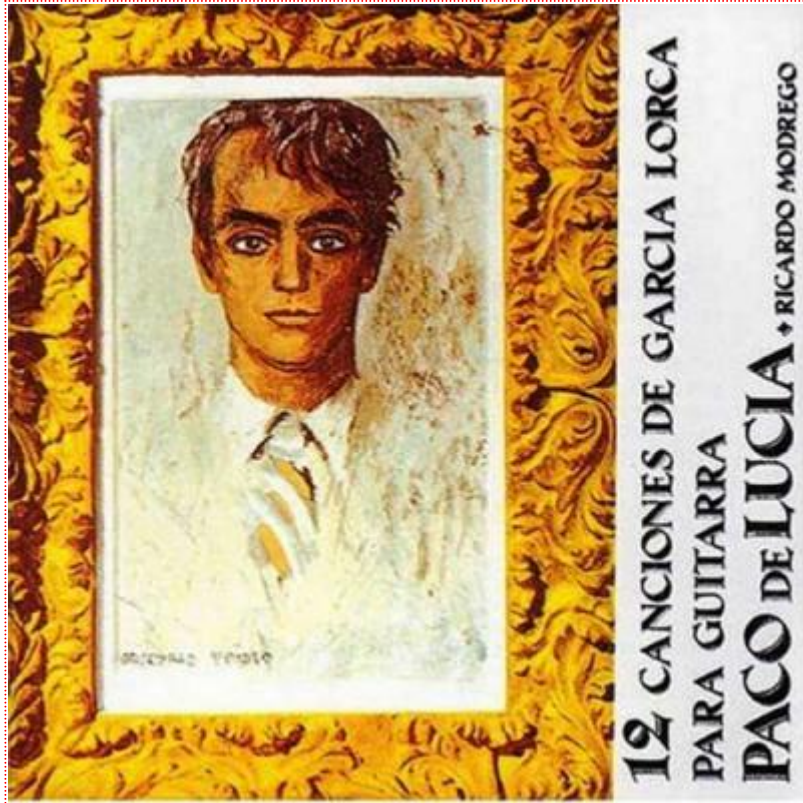

Paco de Lucía was only eighteen when he recorded this album next to Ricardo Modrego. Here he does the arrangements and plays songs compiled in the 20's by Federico García Lorca, leaving his first footprints on a road that would eventually transformed him into one of the greatest creators and contemporary flamenco performers. Ricardo Montenegro toured several times with Paco de Lucía between 1962 and 1964. Together they published several works. The track list selected for this album includes the main popular songs compiled by García Lorca: Tonadillas, Bulerías, Jaleos, Seguidillas. The harmony and synchronization felt increases the value of this inspiring and suggestive piece.
