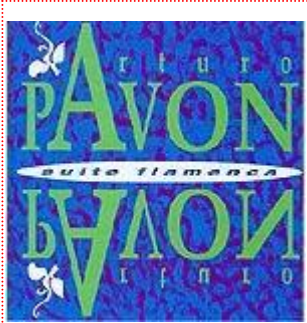

Arturo Pavón was the great Manolo Caracol's son-in-law . Caracol accompanied him on occasion on the piano, the instrument which he coined for Flamenco. Born in Seville in 1931, he belongs to a glorious lineage for he is la Niña de los Peinas and the cantaor Tomás Pavón's nephew. His mother, Eloísa Albéniz, was the director of a mythical baile academy in Seville. Arturo and Luisa Ortega's marriage brought together two cornerstones of the jondo art.
